

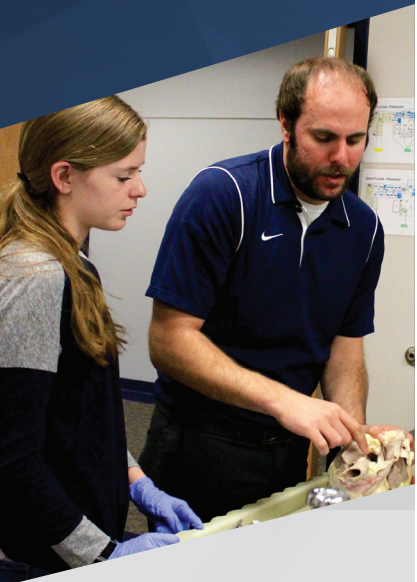


CURRICULUM PHILOSOPHY
